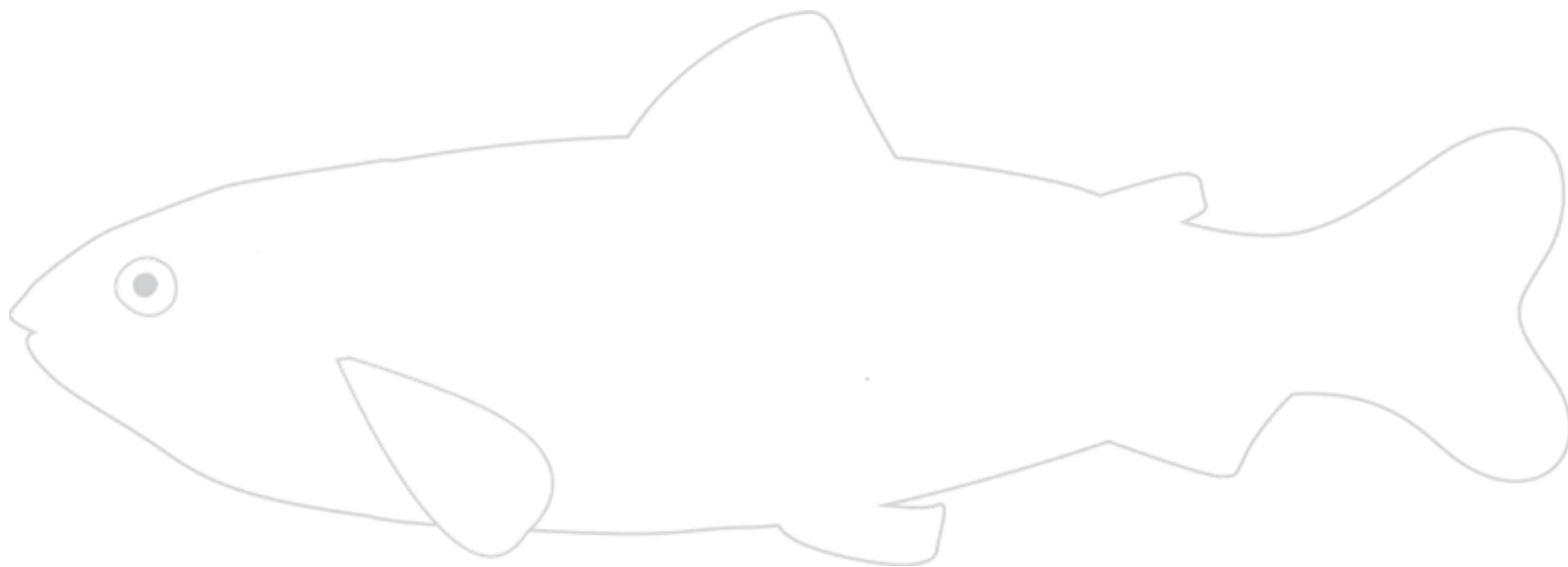

Contest Details

Survive the Sound is an annual educational game hosted by Seattle-based salmon nonprofit Long Live the Kings. Each spring, players come together to watch 48 colorful fish characters attempt their dangerous migration out to the ocean. We have received countless student drawings that have amazed and inspired us, and now one lucky artist will help us design an official Survive the Sound character!

This contest will allow students to submit their own original ideas for a brand new Survive the Sound fish. After all submissions have been received, Long Live the Kings staff will review and select 16 finalists to enter a public vote until only one fish remains. The winner will then have their artwork transformed by a professional illustrator and entered into the 2026 Survive the Sound campaign!

Long Live the Kings has final say in selecting the 16 finalists and retains the right to reject designs for any reason, including but not limited to inappropriate content or similarity to existing intellectual property. By submitting artwork to this contest, participants grant Long Live the Kings full rights to use, modify, reproduce, and display the artwork for any purpose. Participant names and identifying information will be kept private.

Important Dates

March 1, 2025: Contest Begins—start submitting your designs!

December 31, 2025: Last day to submit designs.

January 2026: Finalists are announced and notified,
public votes for their favorite fish.

February 2026: Winner is announced.

March 2026: Final artwork is unveiled!

Submission Guidelines

- All artwork must be completed by students age 18 or younger.
- All submissions must include parent, guardian, or educator contact information (Name and Email).
- All designs must be emailed or postmarked by December 31, 2025.
